Bhubaneswar, Aug 4 (PTI) At least 80 startups working in diverse areas have been recognised by the Startup Odisha Initiative (SOI), a state government agency, during the last two months, officials said today.

This was revealed at the second meeting of the Task Force held under the chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary (MSME) LN Gupta yesterday.

The Task Force also approved monthly allowance grant of Rs 20,000 per month for eight recognised startups.

Officials said 32 more startup applications are under process.
